



## **Disciplinary Procedures for Junior Residential Students.**

If your behavior is not good in class, during social programme activities or in the residence, this is what will happen:

1. **FIRST WARNING** You will get a warning from the person in charge who will tell your group leader and the Director of Studies.
2. **SECOND WARNING** If your behavior is still bad, the Director of Studies will speak to you. You may be stopped from doing afternoon activities and/or evening activities.
3. **THIRD WARNING** If your behavior is still bad, the Director of Studies will speak to you again. You may be stopped from doing afternoon activities and/or evening activities. Also, we will speak to your parents

**Examples of bad behaviour for warnings 1-3 might include:**

**Failure to follow your teacher's or your social organiser's instructions**

**Being rude or using bad language**

**Being unkind to other students**

4. **PRINCIPAL'S WARNING** If your behavior is still bad, the Principal will speak to you. He will also speak to your parents again. You may have to leave the school and go home.

**Examples of very bad behavior. This behavior may mean we go to point 4 directly:**

**Bullying and verbal assault.**

**Shop-lifting, assault, drinking alcohol or fighting.**

**Drug taking will immediately result in expulsion.**
