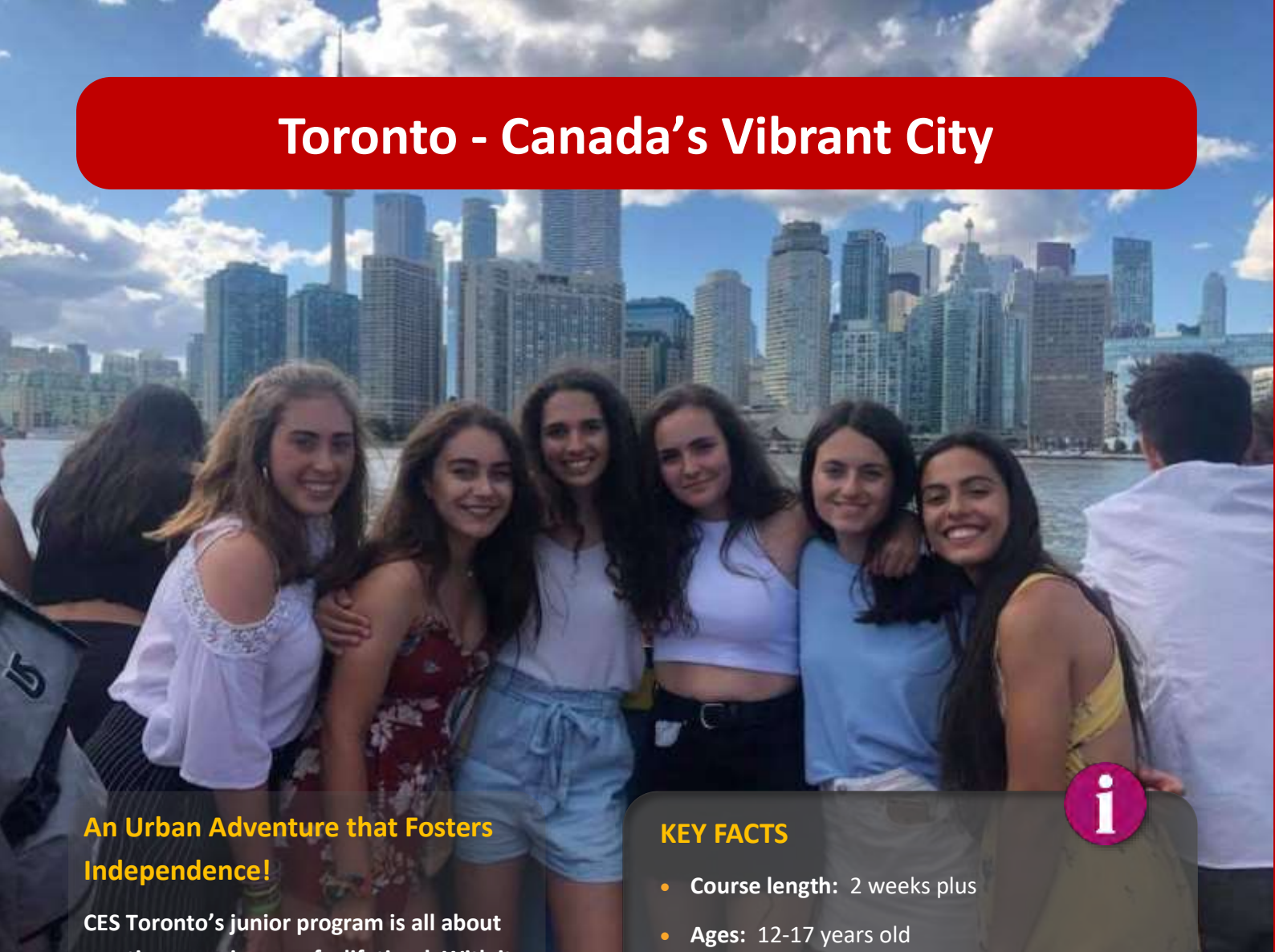

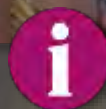
The Centre of English Studies Toronto's Teen Activity Program takes place in downtown Toronto, surrounded by shops and great locations for students to enjoy

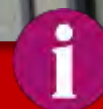

# Residential Accommodation



## KEY FACTS



- **Total number of beds:** 100
- **Type:** single and shared rooms
- **Bathrooms:** shared 1:6
- **Room allocation:** managed by Tartu College and Ryerson University
- **Provided with room:** bed linen (not hairdryers)
- **Food:** Breakfast, pack lunch, and dinner in canteen for residential students
- **Facilities:** Canteen, washing machines (pay per use), common areas
- **WiFi:** available in residence
- **Tartu College:** 5 minutes walk from St. George's Campus
- **Victoria University :** 10 minutes walk St. George's campus

# Host Family Accommodation



## The Homestay Experience

- **Total language immersion** with selected and inspected local families.
- **Rooms:** Single Rooms or Shared rooms (individuals and groups).
- **Food:** Breakfast (includes fruit juice, cereal, toast and preserves and fruit), packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, yoghurt, chips and a drink) and dinner (meat, poultry or fish and fresh vegetables) included in the package.
- **Travel:** 40 – 45 minutes by public transportation.
- **Laundry:** ask host family about laundry and washing arrangements
- **Curfew times:** 15 – 17 years old (22:00 hrs), 12 – 14 years old (21:00). All students to return home by 17:00 for dinner (unless school scheduled evening
